Christ Church Breakfast Club

Everyone is welcome at Christ Church Primary School's Breakfast Club which provides quality childcare for the children from Reception to Year 6. We aim to provide a nutritious and filling breakfast which will prepare your child for the school day. All children are encouraged to join in a variety of activities including access to the outside area.

Food Provided

Cereal: a selection of healthy cereals with semi-skimmed milk.
Brown or white toast with a choice of toppings.
Drinks: orange or apple juice, milk, hot chocolate.
Yoghurts and fromage frais.
Occasionally we will offer crumpets, rolls or croissants.

Opening Times

We are open every weekday during term time from 7.45-8.45am.
Your child can be dropped off at any time between these times.
Breakfast is served until 8.20am.

Access is via the front door from 7.45am.

Bookings

If you would like a place for your child, please complete the booking form in advance.
Your child does not have to attend every day, simply book the days you require.
If you would like a place for your child on a particular day, let the school office know.

Payment

The cost is £5 per day and £4 for a sibling.
Payment is made on Parent Pay and Childcare vouchers are also accepted.
We reserve the right to refuse further bookings if the full fee is not paid.

The club is run and managed by two experienced and enthusiastic members of staff, Mrs Saruhashi, Mrs Abe and a Mrs Kumar, all whom the children know well. Christ Church, the LDBS and the local authority are committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and all staff hold an enhanced DBS check. Staff are also First Aid trained.
