Dear Parent/Guardian,

### **Your child's annual flu vaccination is now due**

This vaccination is recommended to help protect your child against flu and this year is being offered to all children in primary school as well as those in school year 7. Flu can be an unpleasant illness and can cause serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable family and friends by preventing the spread of flu. With COVID-19 in circulation it is more important than ever to reduce the number of those becoming ill with flu this winter to help protect them and the NHS.

The vaccination is free and is a quick and simple spray up the nose. Even if your child had it last year, the type of flu can vary each winter so it is recommended to have the flu vaccine again this year or they won't be protected.

You will need to enter the unique code for your child's school. The code is **CL101316**. Please submit your form well before our team are due to visit the school to ensure your child receives their vaccination. If you experience any problems accessing the form, please telephone your local team on the number provided above and the team will be happy to help.

While COVID-19 is in circulation, the healthcare team and school will follow guidelines to ensure children are safe when being offered the vaccine.
